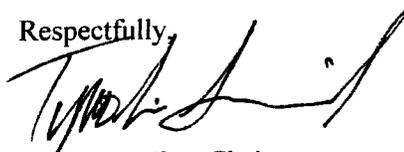

GULF COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION AGENDA POLICY

PURPOSE:

The purpose of agenda policy is to increase public awareness and transparency regarding the issues and topics that will be discussed and possibly acted upon by the Gulf County Board of County Commissioners at its regularly noticed meetings. The established agenda policy will also provide the elected officials and County staff in the various departments an enhanced ability to provide sufficient advance notice of possible topics and issues of discussion that may require board action.

UPDATES:

Future updates to this policy will be the responsibility of the County Commission following the request and receipt of recommendations and review of the County Administrator and thereafter final adoption of any amendments or revisions by the Board of County Commissioners.

AUTHORITY:

This policy establishes its authority and jurisdiction under Florida Statute, Chapter 125

GULF COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING AGENDA POLICY:

It is the general policy of Gulf County Florida that meeting agenda are to be set up, structured and noticed in a responsible, efficient, ethical, and legal manner to support the public awareness and better serve both the public, the elected officials and the County staff of Gulf County, Florida.

PROCEDURE:

This policy is applicable to all Gulf County Commissioners, employees and the public requesting to be placed on the agenda.

POLICY & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Primary responsibilities relating to setting the Commission agenda are outlined below:

County Commissioner request for Agenda Item and/or Amendment to the noticed Agenda:

County Administration shall:

1. Receive the Commissioners requests for agenda items up to the day of the meeting date.
2. If the request for an agenda item is received the Wednesday prior to the regular meeting date, the agenda item shall be placed on the meeting notice and agenda.
3. If the request is received following 12 p.m. the Wednesday prior to the regular meeting date, the Administrative staff shall notify the Commission at the opening of the regular session of the meeting of the list of agenda amendment requests for addition to the noticed agenda. At

which time a motion of the Commissioner seeking the amendment shall be required for suspension of the agenda notice and scheduling policy:

- i. The motion shall include the Commissioners stated purpose for the inclusion of the agenda item (ie. emergency issue due to time constraints, public safety, personnel matters, immediate funding concerns, preservation of county property, legal requirements cited by the County Attorney, public benefit and or civic support and involvement by the Board of Commissioners)
- ii. Following a second from the Board, the motion shall require a super majority (4 affirmative votes) to both suspend the agenda policy for the stated purpose and amend the agenda to include the issue presented from the Commissioner
- iii. The amended agenda shall thereafter reflect the additions to the agenda included County Commission.

County Staff Requests for Amendment to Agenda:

4. The County staff and professionals shall notify the Commission of agenda amendment requests following the same notice procedures stated above.

Forms to be utilized by both Commissioners and County Staff

5. The County Commission as well as County staff shall be required to submit the attached agenda request form** to have items officially placed on the meeting agenda up until 12 p.m. on the Wednesday prior to the regular meeting date and time. Thereafter, the agenda amendment requests shall also be submitted by the Commission and or staff, however the procedure and approval must be conducted in order for the agenda amendment to be accepted.

**(County forms for agenda request/amendment shall be subject to change per the future request and authorization of either the County Commission and/or County Administrator.)

Public Requests for Agenda Amendment

6. If the request for the inclusion of an agenda item is presented from the public (citizen) following Wednesday at 12 p.m. prior to the regular meeting date, the Board may elect to consider a motion and endorsement from a seated Commissioner who may present the request in the form of a motion to amend the agenda, that shall also then follow the requirements and procedure set forth in Paragraph 3 above. The citizen shall complete the public agenda request form for administrative notice and scheduling of the meeting.***

Current County policy regarding allotment of time shall continue with this policy, where public requests providing notice prior to 12 p.m. the Wednesday prior to the regular meeting date shall receive an allotted six (6) minutes for their presentation and comments and those received after the notice cutoff, if permitted and motioned onto the Agenda shall be permitted three (3) minutes for their comments and presentation.

***(County forms for Public Requests to be placed on the agenda /amendment shall be subject to change per the future request and authorization of either the County Commission and/or County Administrator.)

Dear Mr. Koon:

I am writing to request your support to maintain the current funding level of County Emergency Management Program Base Grants funded through the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG). I am aware that under the recently released federal grant guidance the Florida EMPG allocation was reduced by \$229,990; however I strongly encourage the Division of Emergency Management (DEM) to absorb this reduction by reducing the EMPG funds retained by DEM.

It is my understanding that the Fiscal Year 2013-14 General Appropriations Act (GAA) recently signed by Governor Scott includes EMPG budget authority of approximately \$5.7 million in operating costs for the Division. The GAA also includes \$5.8 million in pass through budget authority for county EMPG base grants, the current Fiscal Year 2012-2013 funding level. In addition, the GAA provides an additional \$4.5 million in "lump sum" EMPG budget authority for the Division. Given the \$14.6 million available under Florida's EMPG allocation, DEM can maintain funding levels for both its operational costs as well as County Base Grants and fully absorb the \$229,990 reduction in available 2013 federal funding without affecting essential services provided by DEM and county programs.

To remain eligible for federal EMPG dollars, counties must provide a dollar for dollar match from non-federal sources. Most county emergency management programs rely on federal EMPG funds and the requisite local match to support basic operational costs needed to meet state statutory responsibilities required of county emergency management programs. These operational expenditures include personnel, expenses and direct costs to sustain day to day emergency response and recovery capabilities. Florida is very fortunate to have extremely robust county emergency management programs with capable and experienced personnel. The overwhelming majority of Florida's emergency incidents have impacts that are addressed and resolved locally without the need for state or federal intervention or assistance. Any reduction in federal EMPG funds to county programs will reduce this capability and compromise community safety.

Thank you for this opportunity to provide input on this important issue. I urge you to continue to support county emergency management programs and not reduce county EMPG funding. As always, if you have any questions or need additional information please call me at (850) 229-9110.
