### Staging Areas

**Windmark/St. Joe Beach Parking Lot**  
(St. Joe Beach)

**Salinas Park**  
(Cape San Blas & Indian Pass)

Please meet at one of the 2 staging areas and volunteers will be organized into teams and directed to a zone of beach to clean. All teams will have trained team leaders. We will need many more people at Salinas Park than at St. Joe beach due to beaches to be covered

### Why are we cleaning up now?

While we are still uncertain if Gulf County will be affected by the oil spill, we need to clean our beaches now in order to be prepared. If our beaches are free of manmade debris/trash, there will be less contaminated debris if we are impacted by the oil spill.

### Who can volunteer for the beach cleanup?

- Anyone who wants to help!
- NO prior training is needed but environmental awareness training will be provided upon arrival for the clean up
- Children are welcome; Under 15 needs to be accompanied by an adult.

### What do Volunteers need to bring?

- Closed toe shoes
- Sunscreen/Protective Clothing
- Snacks/drinks
- Sunglasses/Hats
- Gloves
- Bug Spray
